The Nine Mile Run Watershed is a small urban watershed located in Pittsburgh's East End. Covering just 6.5 square miles, the watershed is home to numerous exciting initiatives, including one of the largest and most successful urban stream and wetland restorations in the United States. The Nine Mile Run Watershed Association (NMRWA) complements this amazing physical transformation with a variety of innovative urban ecology projects designed to directly involve the community in helping to improve water quality in the stream, and the overall health of the watershed.

NMRWA offers internship opportunities on an ongoing basis. This is a chance for a young professional to gain valuable experience working directly with our staff in our various program areas. Specifics

Interns will be expected to work a minimum of 6-12 hours a week, with at least 3 hours per shift. Candidates must be able to arrange their own transportation to our office. If you are a student, all scheduled school holidays will be recognized. NMRWA cannot usually offer financial compensation, but we will help facilitate the pursuit of college credit. Students eligible for federal work study are strongly encouraged to apply. We will also provide a letter of recommendation and reference to interns who successfully complete their internships.
